Carlos Alberto Montaner is one of the most influential and widely-read journalist in Spanish-language media. His weekly column has been published for over two decades in numerous newspapers across the Hispanic World. He has written numerous books including *Twisted Roots: Latin America's Living Past* and *Journey to the Heart of Cuba: Life As Fidel Castro*. He has also been a university professor in Latin America, the United States and Spain.

Madeline Cámara is a professor, essay writer and literary critic. She teaches Latin American Literature at University of South Florida. Dr. Cámara is a specialist in Cuban Studies. Among her books are: *Vocación de Casandra* (2000) and *Imagining a Matria* (2008). She has coedited *Cuba: the Ellusive Nation* (2002) and more recently *María Zambrano: Palabras para el Mundo* (2011). She writes a literary column for El Nuevo Herald.

Grace Piney co-authored the book *Cuba: arte y literatura en exilio* with James Pancrazio. She is a publisher who, after having founded two publishing houses, now serves as the director of Legua Editorial. Since 2000, she has directed the International Congress "Con Cuba en la distancia." Her research centers on international cooperation for development (Spain, Cuba).
