

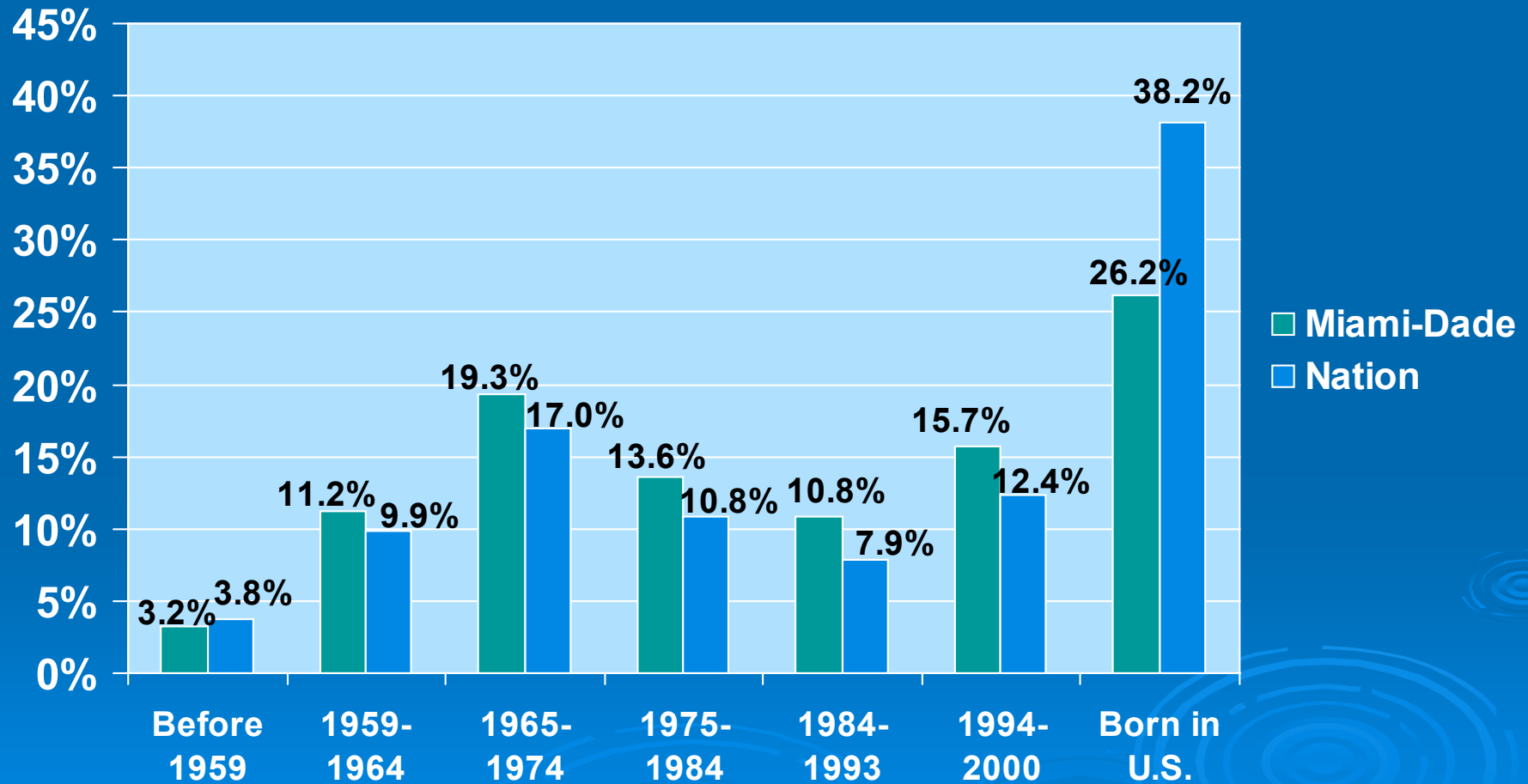

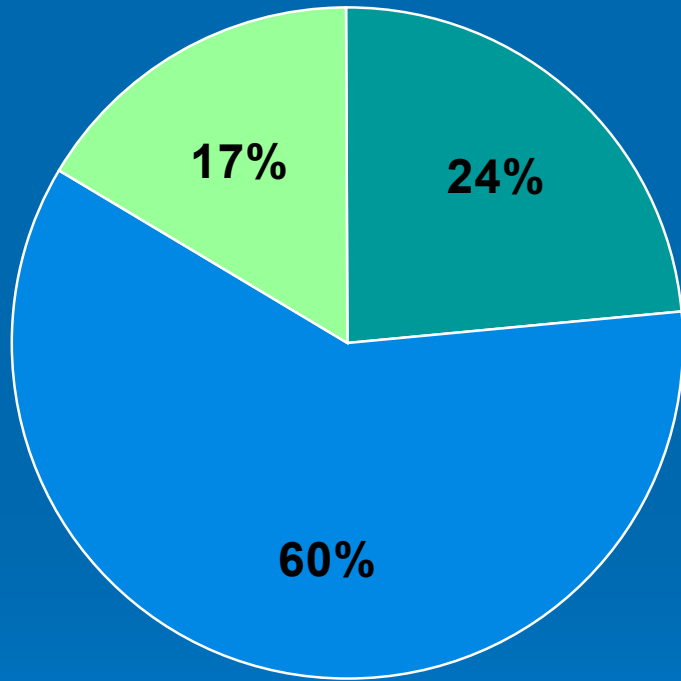

Cubans' Year of Immigration

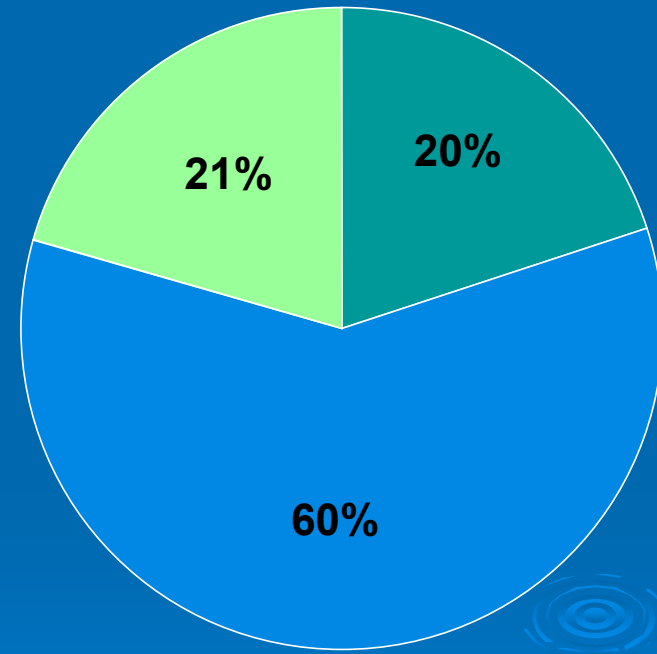


Age of Cubans in U.S.



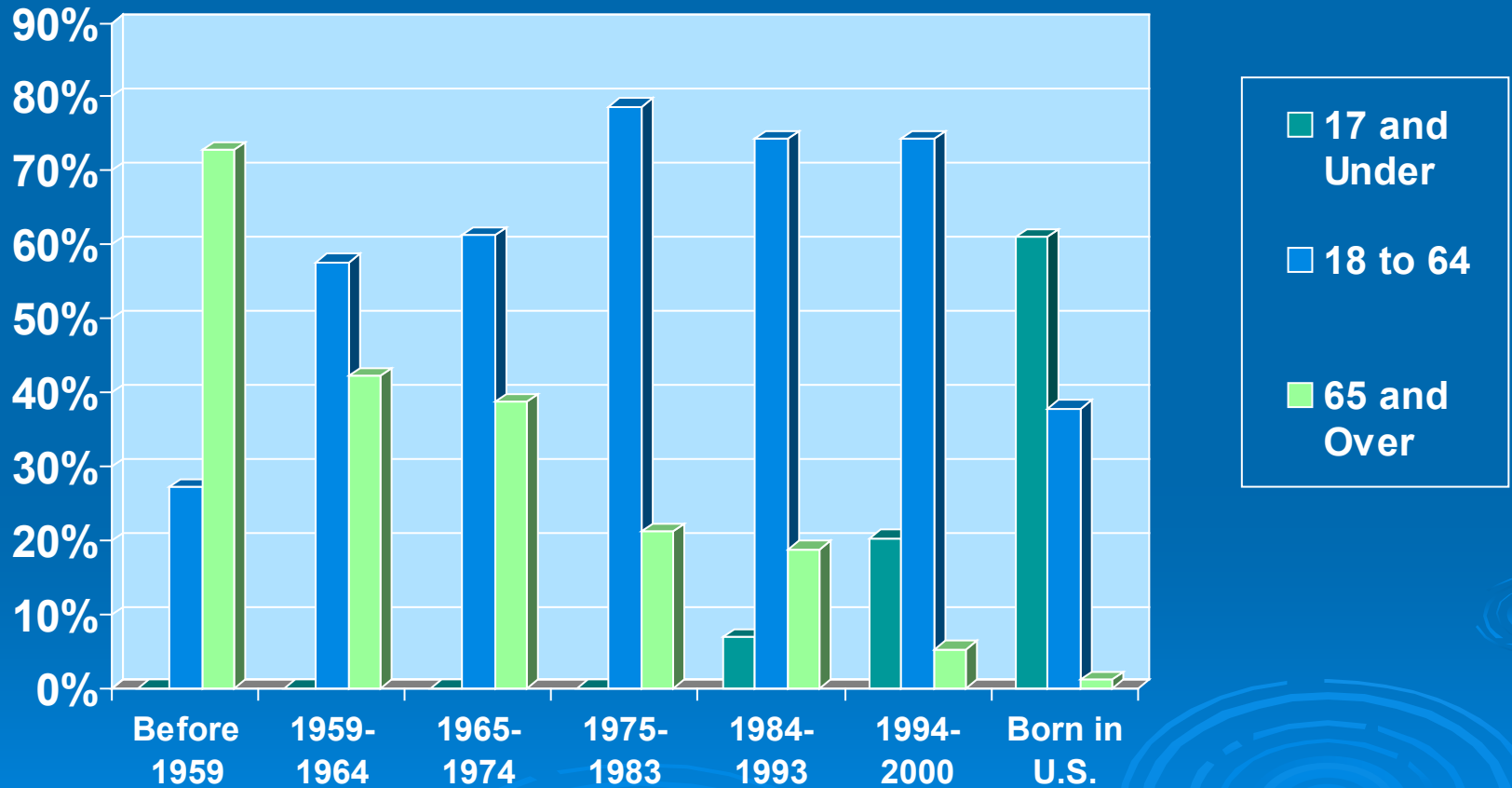

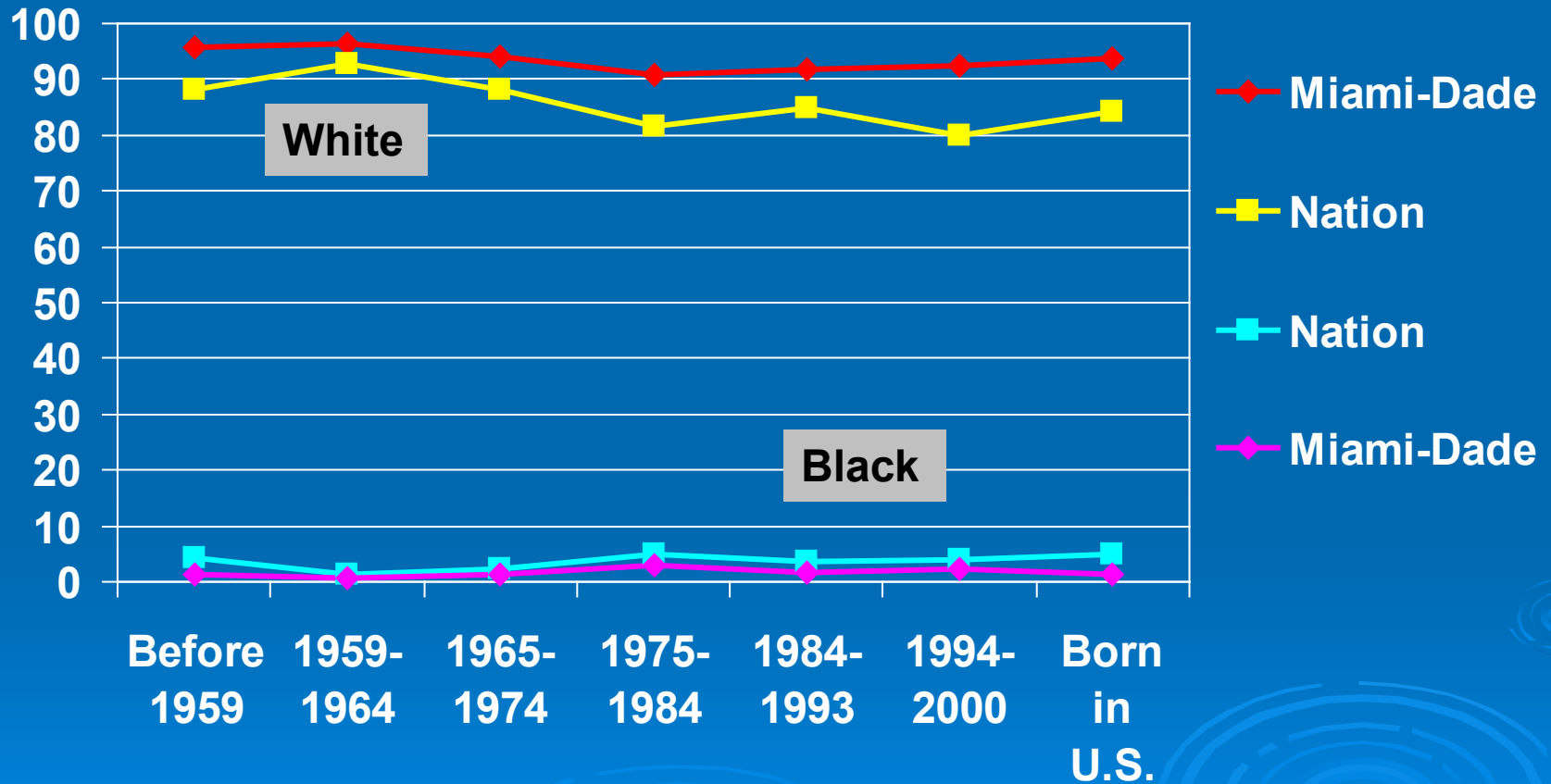

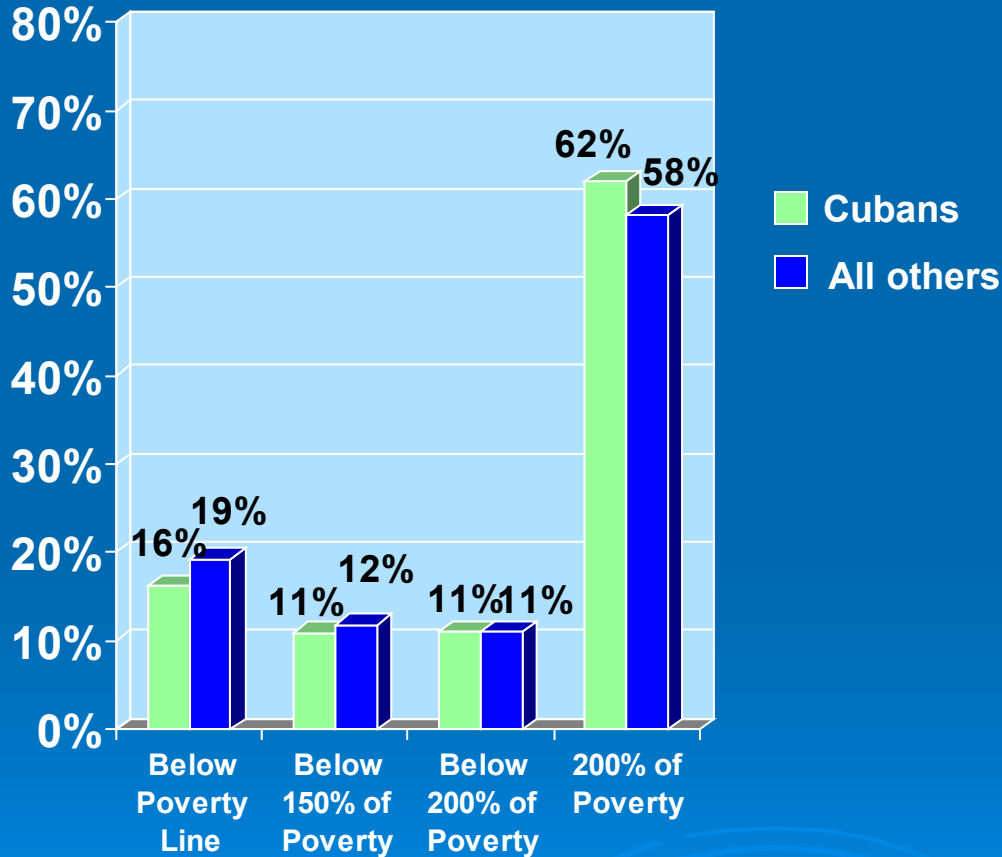
Age by Wave, Miami-Dade



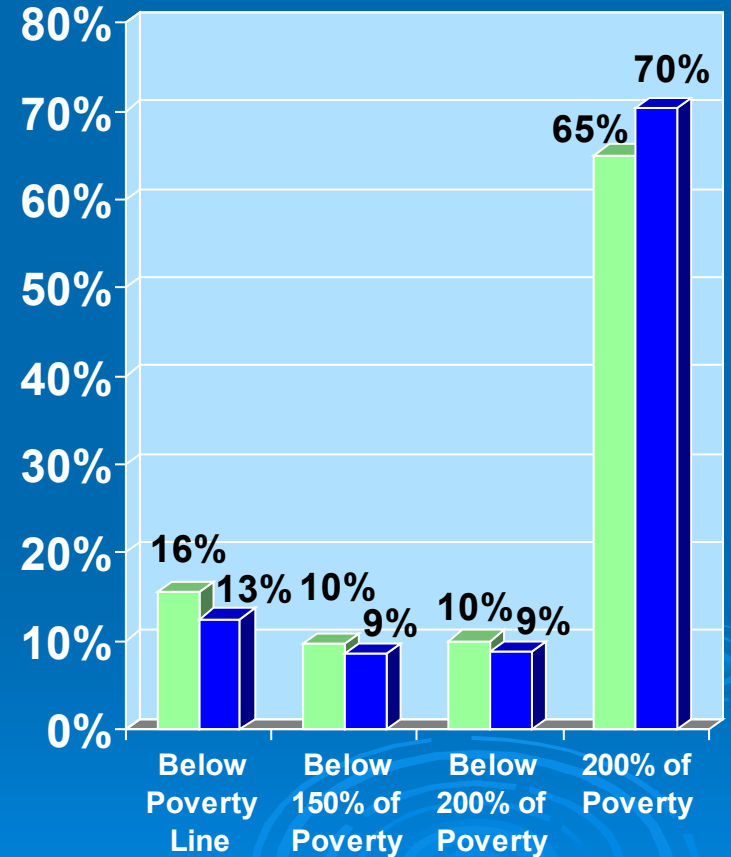
Cuban Percent white and black, by wave



Comparative Cuban Poverty: Miami and the U.S.

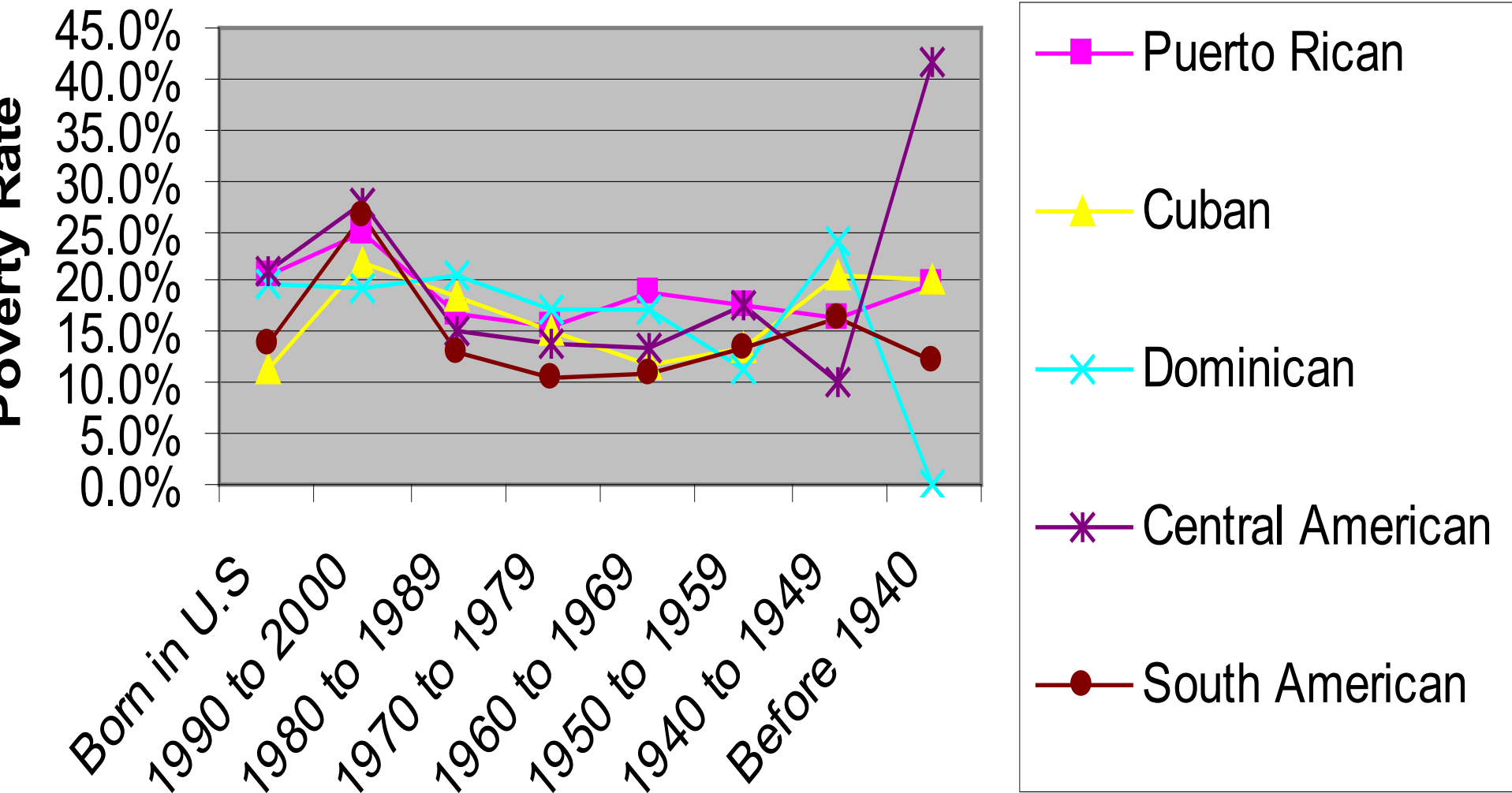

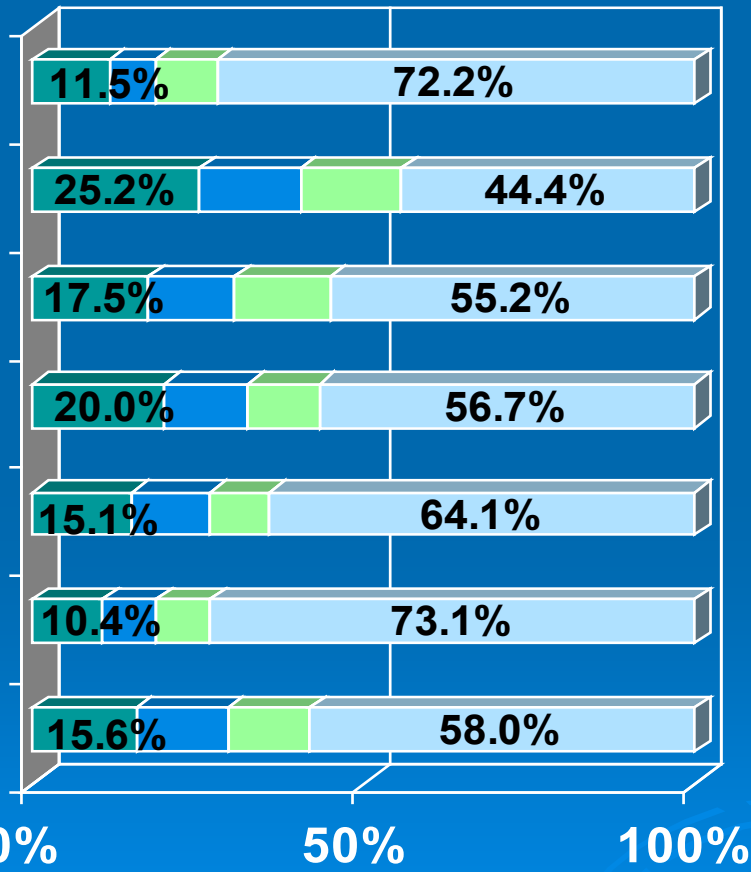

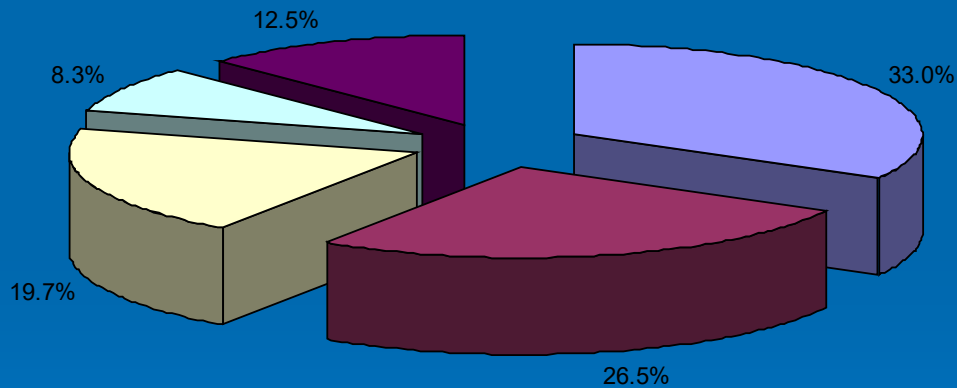

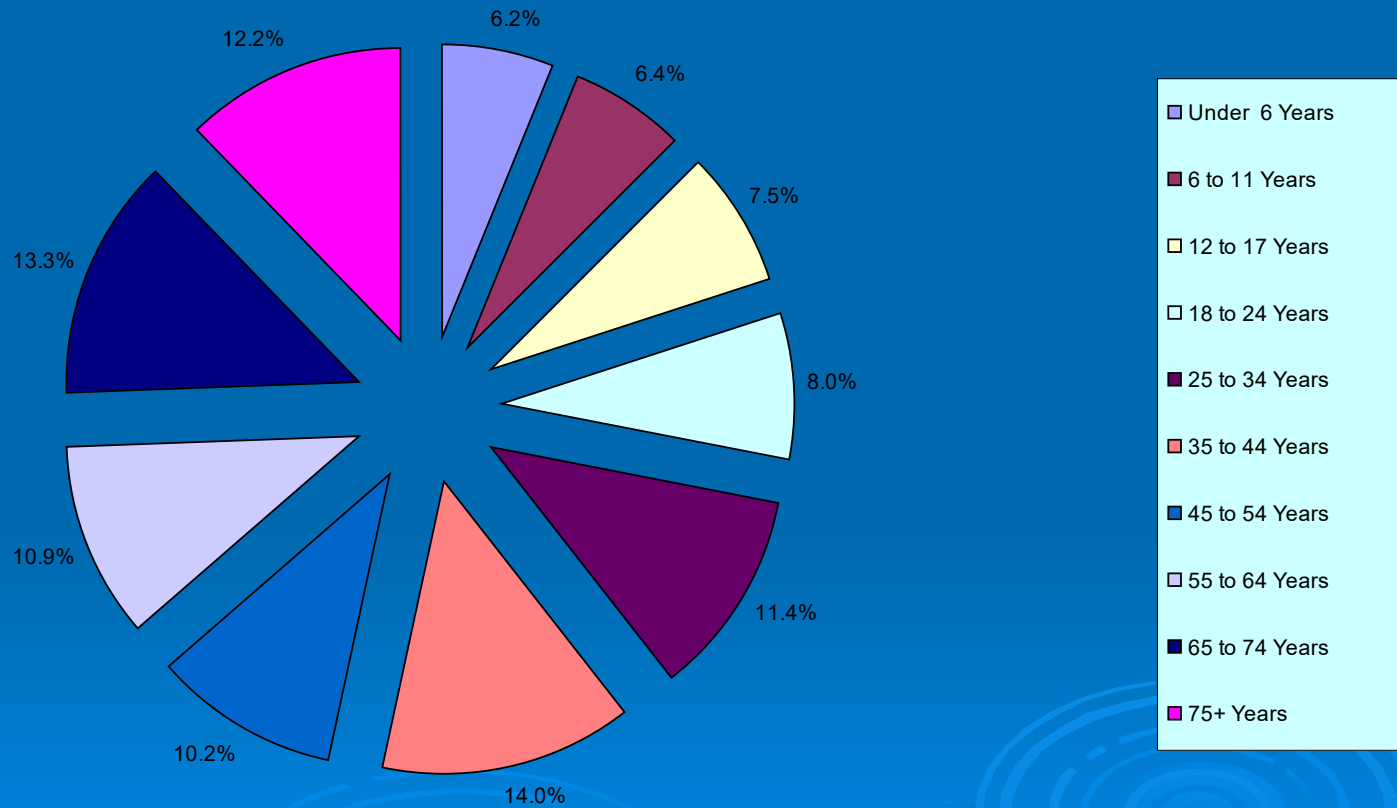

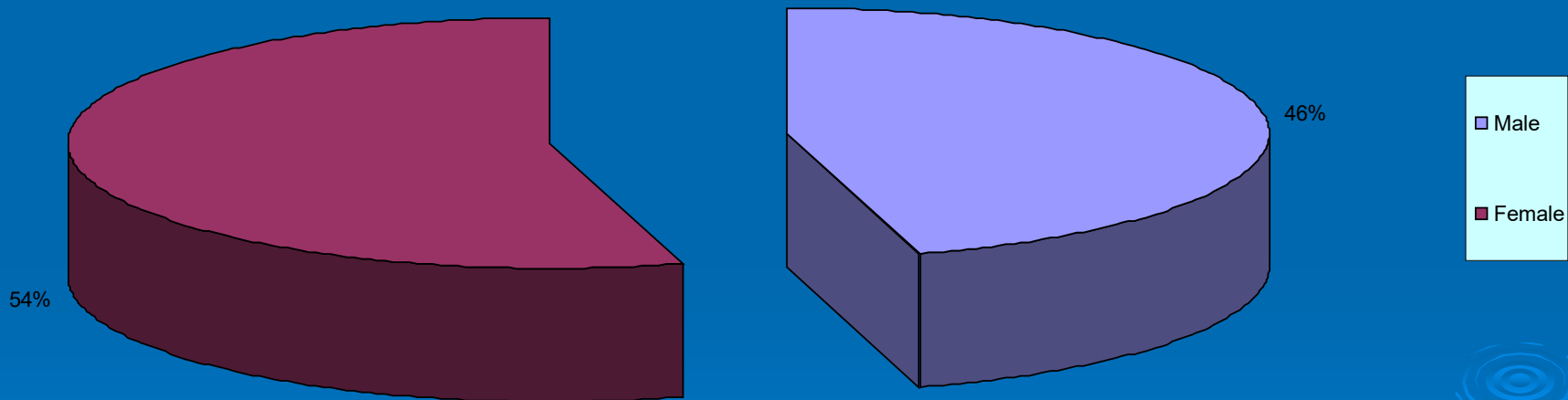

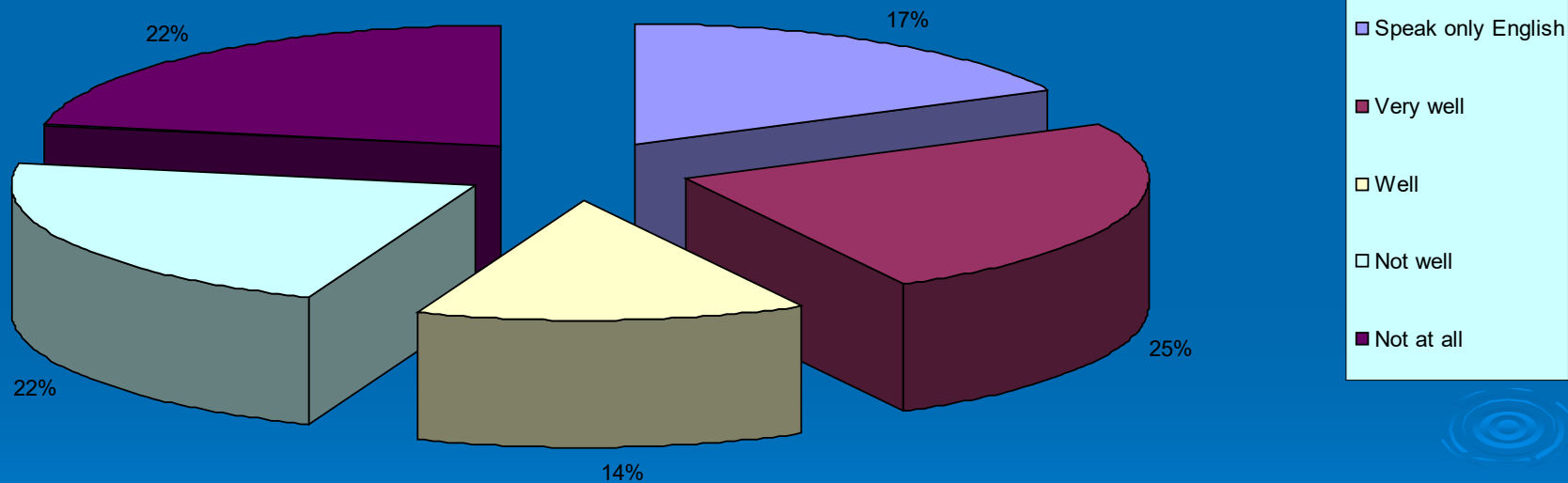
Age Distribution of Cuban-American Poor



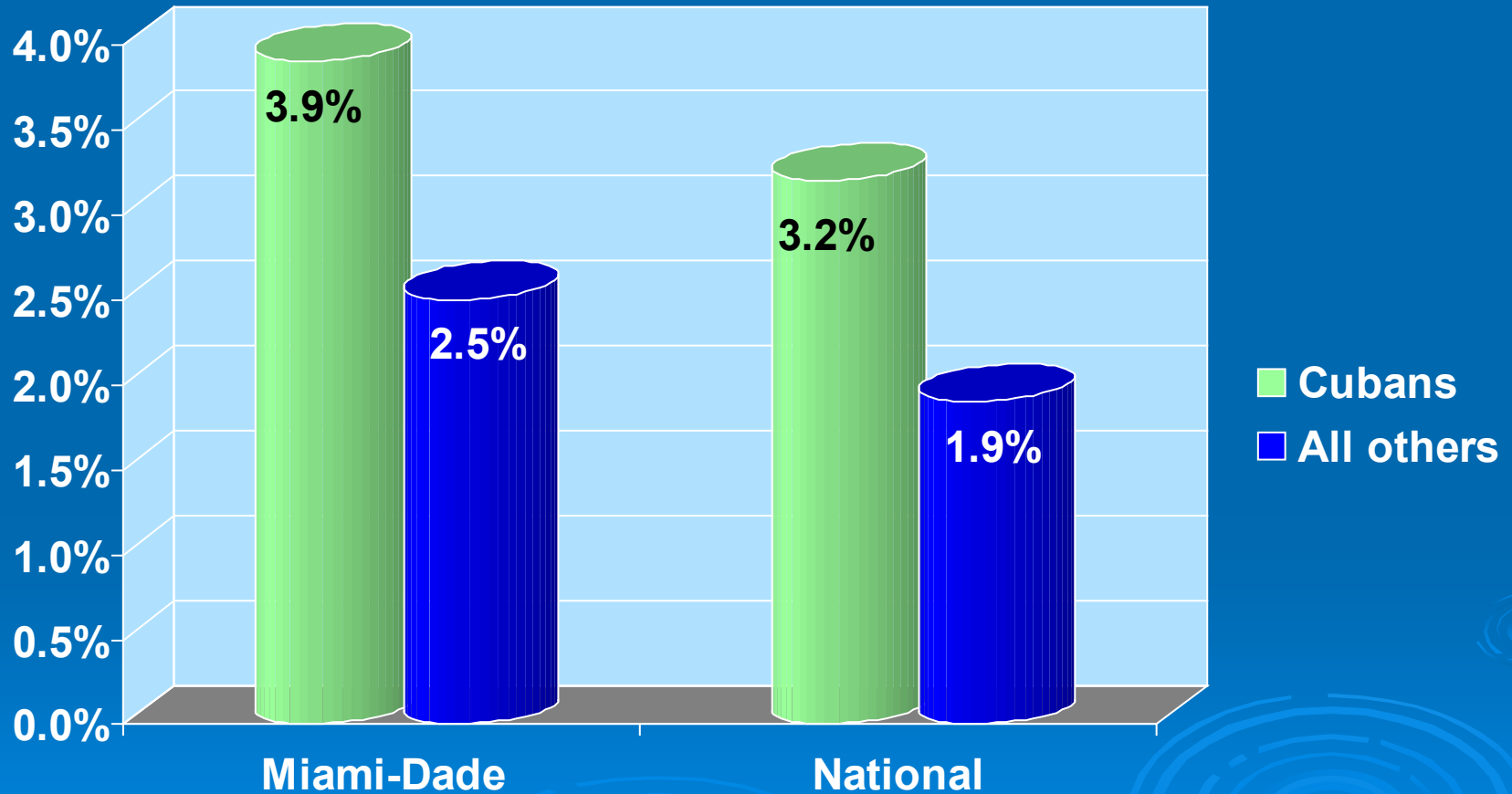
Sex Distribution of Cuban-American Poor



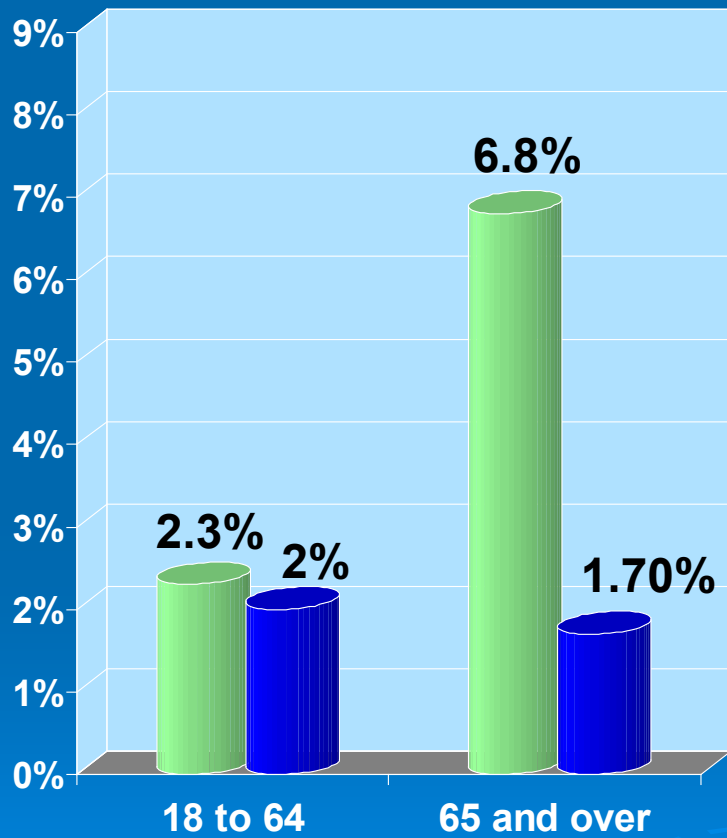
English Fluency of the Cuban-American Poor



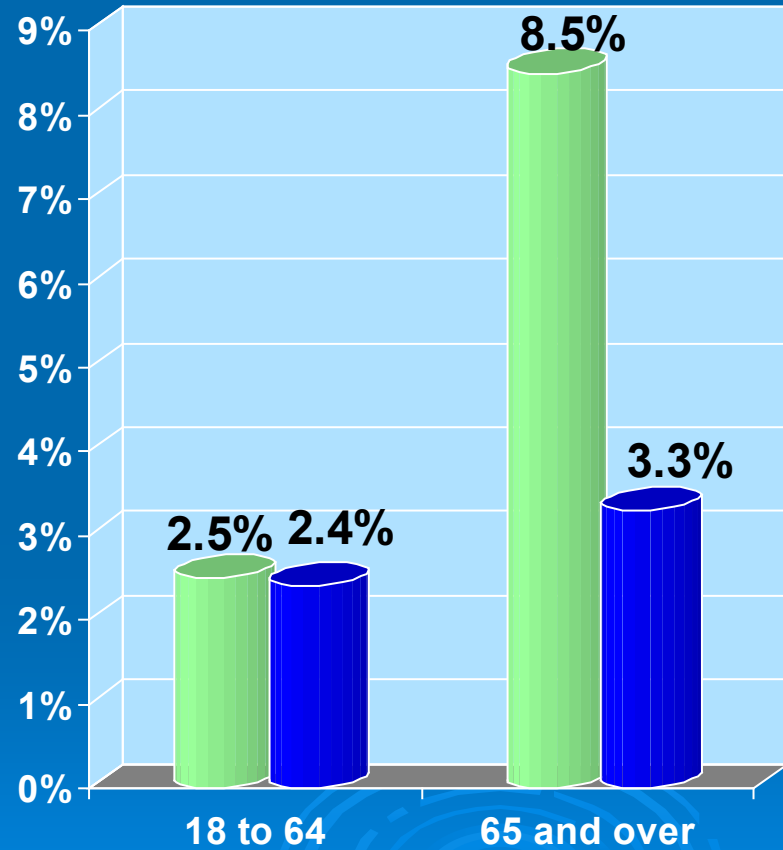

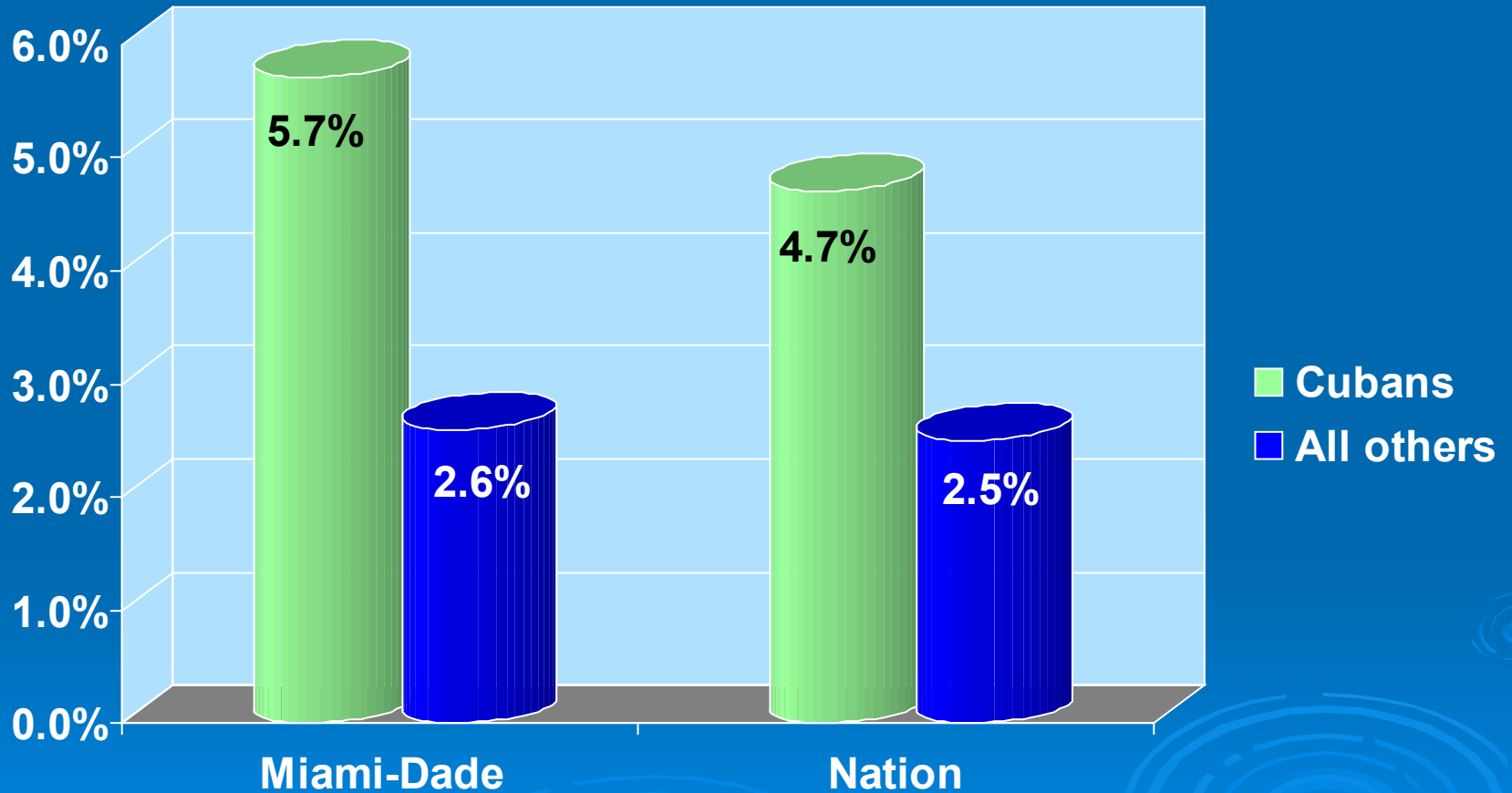

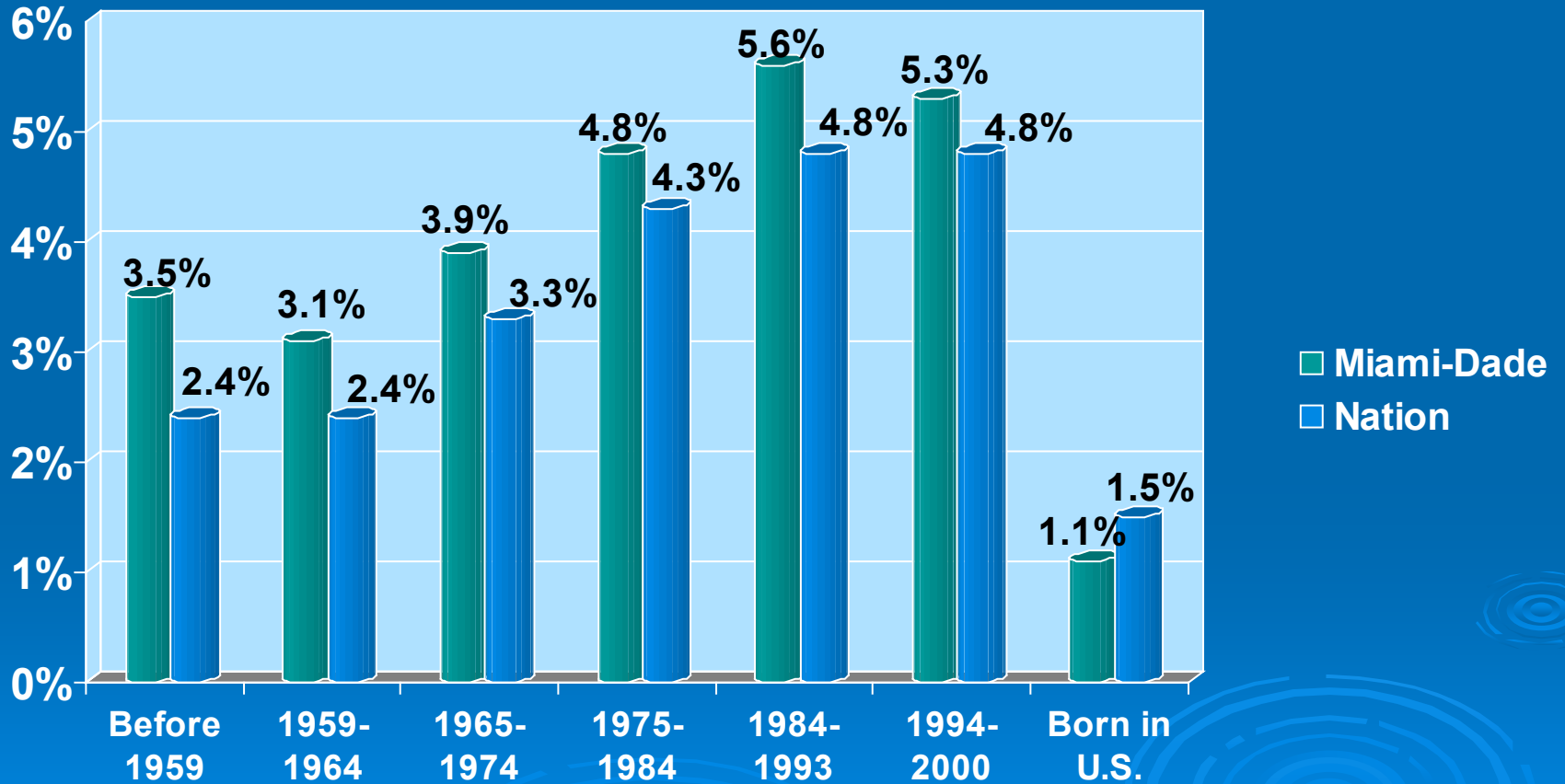

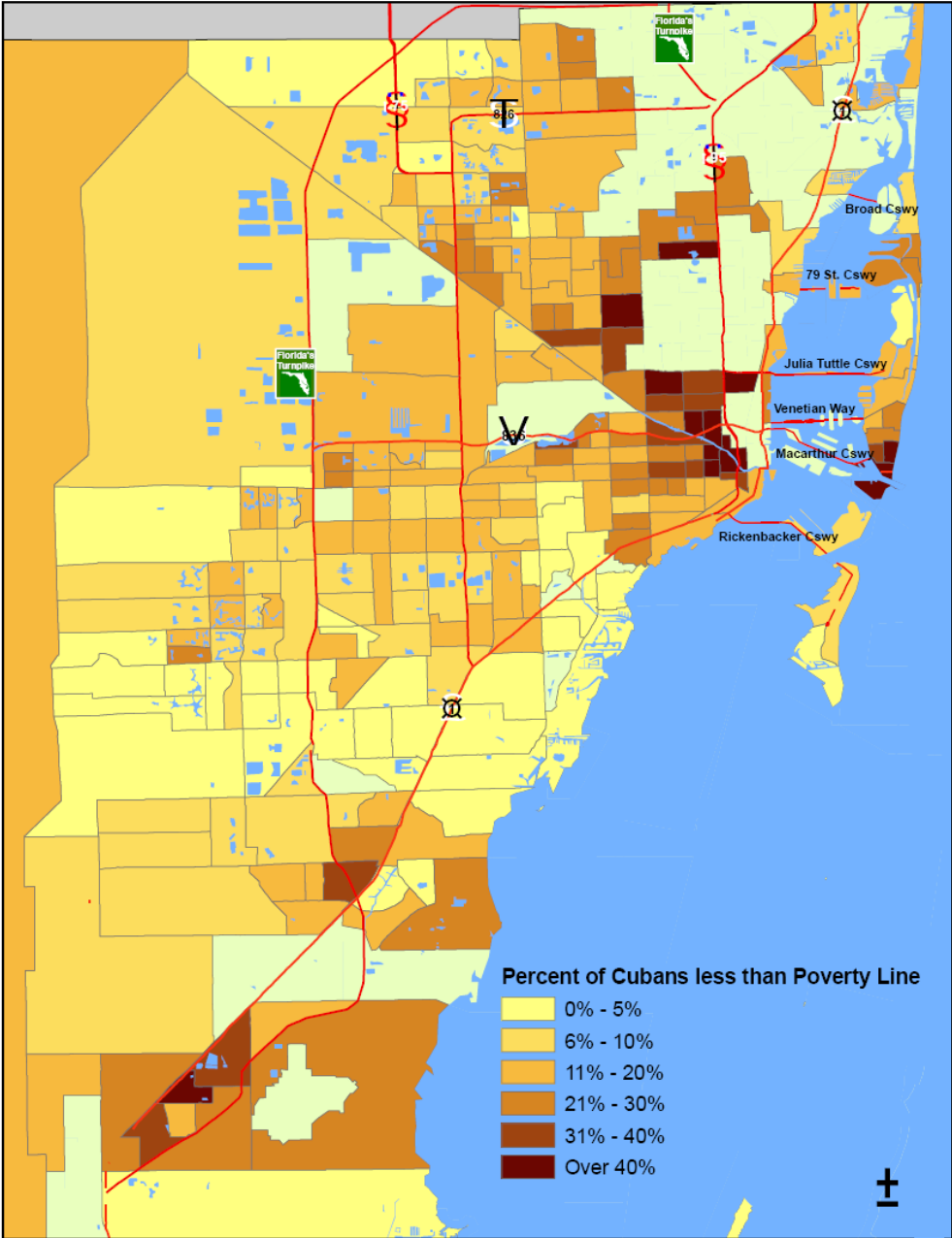
