



### **Cubans' Year of Immigration**




# Age of Cubans in U.S.




### Age by Wave, Miami-Dade



# Cuban Percent white and black, by wave









# Poverty by Race Nationally Miami-Dade








#### Age Distribution of Cuban-American Poor



#### Sex Distribution of Cuban-American Poor




