Twenty Florida League leaders took part in the initial effort to explore areas of mutual interest and cooperation. Dorrit Marks is Vice President of the League of Women Voters of Miami-Dade. Elizabeth Pines is a League of Women Voters Board Director and is an immigration attorney specializing in employment-based immigration. She has worked on advocacy initiatives with the American Immigration Lawyers Association and has written columns on immigration in El Venezolano, a newspaper based in Miami, and Doral Family Journal, an internet based newspaper. She is an alumni and active participant at the Wedgeworth Leadership Institute, an organization that develops the capabilities of young leaders.

Annie Betancourt is Vice President of the League of Women Voters of Florida and concurrently Vice President of the League of Miami-Dade County. She is a past president of the Miami-Dade League, served on the South Florida Water Management District and was a Florida Legislator until term-limited. She is coordinating the Florida League's Sisters Across the Straits project.
