2011 Cuba Poll


648 randomly selected Cuban-American respondents were polled in Miami-Dade County. Interviews were completed on September 19, 2011. The margin of error for the overall poll is plus or minus 3.9%. This is the tenth in the series of Cuba Polls conducted by the Principal Investigators (Grenier/Gladwin) since1991. Overall results are weighted to be representative of the Cuban-American community of Miami-Dade County as a whole.






Do you favor or oppose continuing the **U.S. embargo of Cuba?**




Do you think that the embargo has worked...?




Establishing a national dialogue among Cuban exiles, Cuban dissidents, and representatives of the Cuban government?




Allow companies to sell medicine to Cuba?




Allowing U.S. companies to sell food to Cuba?




Should this kind of trade be expanded, kept the same or stopped?



Should unrestricted travel by all Americans to Cuba be allowed or not?




Do you favor or oppose the U.S. reestablishing diplomatic relations with **Cuba**?




PRIVATE ENTERPRISES IN CUBA


Overall, do you think this change is going make things better, worse, or not make any difference for people living in Cuba?

Would you invest in a private enterprise in Cuba if given the opportunity?




Do you have any close relatives still living in Cuba?

Do they think that this change will make things better, worse or not make any difference? (N=156)




Would you like your congregation/synagogue to become involved in Cuba? (N=266)
